



Deal or No Deal – Banker's Code

Overview

Banker's Code captures the spirit of the Deal or No Deal game environment and adapts it to a puzzle game for mobile platforms. People who enjoy the television show will be able to play Deal or No Deal on the go.

Gameplay

Banker's Code is a puzzle game for mobile platforms which captures the spirit of the show. The player must memorize a sequence and correctly enter it, or suffer the consequences. This sequence game is an overlay to the standard Deal or No Deal game, giving a deeper experience for the player.

Howie Mandel acts as the host, guiding the player through each step of gameplay. The overall look of the game resembles the show's music color scheme. The number pad provides the ability to input the correct sequence, accept or deny a deal, and view monetary amounts.

The player must initially choose a single briefcase that contributes to the last decision of the game. She is then presented with a sequence of numbers to input as it progresses. If the player successfully enters the sequence, she can then strategically remove briefcases. If she is not successful, the program will remove values at random. At the end of each round, "the banker" offers the player an option to take a lump sum of money with which to walk away. If the player forgets the sequence, she has an ability to ask a computerized friend for help.

In order to promote competition, the game saves the player's longest sequence in order to compete against others worldwide for high ranks.
